Aphabet comparision

The Abjadi order is commonly vocalized as follows:
 'abjad hawwaz ḥuṭṭī kalaman sa'faṣ qarashat thakhadh ḍaḏagh.

The Abjadī order (الترتيب الأبجدي) is the original alphabetical order of Arabic letters, used historically in Semitic scripts (like Phoenician, Hebrew, and early Arabic). It's still used today in things like numbering lists and Abjad numerals, where each letter corresponds to a number.

Chronogram for the Construction of Charminar:
 The phrase "يا حافظ" (Yā Ḥāfiẓ), translating to "O Protector!", serves as a chronogram for the construction of Hyderabad's Charminar. The combined Abjad values total 1000 AH, equivalent to 1591 CE, marking the monument's completion year.
